


And he found a fresh jawbone of a donkey, and put out his hand and took it, and with it he struck 1,000 men.

it's like a person punching himself in the face because his fist doesn't like what his face looks like.



I believe in the filling of the Holy Spirit, but I also believe you can leak.




Do not quench the Spirit.

...That they settle for NO fire!


